Provisional Agenda

1. Addressing child trafficking as an aggravated Human Rights abuse of a transnational dimension.
2. Identification of victims.
3. Harmonization of laws to protect, assist and integrate victims.
4. Identification of traffickers and their networks.
5. Ensuring an adequate legal framework for the criminalization of trafficking and punishment of the traffickers.
6. Soliciting cooperation and coordination between States in order to combat the internationally organized crime of trafficking in children.
7. Strengthening the cooperation between States, International Organizations and NGO's aiming at preventing trafficking in children.
