Resolution 11 (2004)

Adopted by the Security Council at its 10th meeting, on 10 August 2004

The Security Council,

Being alarmed by reports on the current crisis in the North of Iraq,

Condemning the recent violent ongoing concerning Iraq,

Recalling all its previous resolutions on that topic,

Calls upon every party concerned in and outside Iraq to refrain from any action leading to the escalation of the conflict;

Encourages all members of the International Community to voluntarily assist in restoring security in Iraq;

Decides to remain seized of the matter.
