Resolution 13 (2005)

Adopted by the Security Council at its 11th meeting, on 10 August 2005

The Security Council,

Recalling UN Security Council Resolution 1540,

Recognizing the importance of solving international tensions and conflicts by peaceful means according to UN Charter,

Deeply regretting that the Islamic Republic of Iran has decided to terminate its diplomatic relations with the Republic of France,

Alarmed by the tension recently erupted between the Islamic Republic of Iran and the State of Israel,

Welcoming the decision of the State of Israel to suspend the military manoeuvre as a step to build confidence between each other and with the international community,

Reaffirming the right of every party to the Non Proliferation Treaty to research, produce and use nuclear energy for peaceful purposes without discrimination in accordance with Article IV of the NPT,

Conscious of the special security concerns of the State of Israel regarding the Iranian nuclear programme,

Emphasizing the importance of respecting the Universal Human Rights under all conditions, especially in times of tension and conflict,

- 1. Declares that the international community will not tolerate military action against other sovereign states by any state in the region, not withholding the right of self-defence under Article 51 of the UN Charter;
- Strongly urges the Islamic Republic of Iran and the State of Israel to refrain from large scale military preparations whose definition is subject to verification of the Committee on Disarmament;
- 3. Appeals to all states possessing appropriate means to contribute to the resolution of the crisis by supporting the Islamic Republic of Iran and the State of Israel in a confidence building process;
- 4. *Reaffirms* the determination of the United Nations to take action to prevent proliferation of nuclear weapons;

- 5. *Urges* the Islamic Republic of Iran to resume its diplomatic relations with the Republic of France;
- 6. *Calls upon* the Islamic Republic of Iran to continue its negotiations with the E3/ EU and its cooperation with the IAEA;
- 7. *Recommends* to the Islamic Republic of Iran to formalise its commitments to the Non Proliferation Treaty and the Additional Protocol by ratifying the Additional Protocol;
 - 8. *Decides* to remain seized of the matter.
